Schunk made 25 saves for the Vikings (4-7).

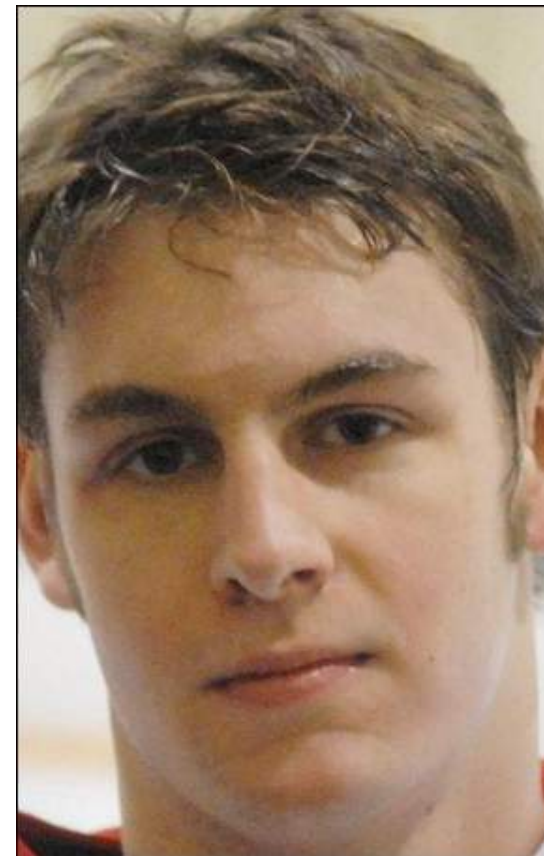
Rocco Benvenuti made 15 saves for the Saints (3-2-1, 7-4-1).
