Old coach tops Northern, 3-1

PORT HURON TWP.- On his third try, Daryl McCarrel was able to knock off his former team on Saturday.

The 19-year Port Huron Northern coach guided Anchor Bay to a 3-1 victory against the ninth-ranked Huskies at Glacier Pointe Ice Complex.

Kevin Moore had a goal and an assist for the Tars.

"It's always nice to coach against them," McCarrel said. "I coached (Northern senior) Ryan Axsom as a freshman and also their whole coaching staff.

"Billy (Warren) has a really good program over there."

The Tars (5-8-1) got a good start when Steve DeGrande scored from Paul DeGrande and Moore 11:30 into the game.

One minute later, Zach Taylor scored from Brian Sullivan.

"Playing games like this will help our program get noticed around the state," McCarrel said. "If we stay focused and get mentally prepared for games, we can win."

The Tars made it 3-0 in the second period when Moore scored on a goal from Brandon Budzyn with 30 seconds on the clock.

"That was an important goal," McCarrel said. "It
