

# League heavies battle to a draw

Saint Clair Shores Unified, Farmington end in a showcase stalemate, 1-1

It was the marquee matchup of the day. And it provided no definite answer to the question on everyone's mind: Which league has better hockey, the Oakland Activities Association or the Macomb Area Conference?

Saint Clair Shores Unified and Farmington battled to a 1-1 draw on Saturday night. The Lakers (12-3-2) represented the top-ranked position for the MAC, while the Falcons (12-4-2) did the same for the OAA.

Junior forward Nick Izaguirre scored for Shores, in what was a playoff-like atmosphere at The Onyx in Rochester.

"For our guys to play them and come close to beating them, I feel it's a feather in our cap and a feather in the league's cap," Lakers coach Frank DiCristofaro said. "I thought we had more scoring chances than them, but we didn't shoot the puck enough. I told this to my guys and I'm sure their coach did as well and that's to give them no space. If they have the puck, put the body on them."

Playing the body was clearly at the top of both teams' agendas. There were enough monster hits in the first period alone to more than cover a normal regular-season game.

Ultimately, it was the hard-nosed play that dominated the action from start to finish.

"The video replay showed that it was not a goal," DiCristofaro said after the game. "Unfortunately, this isn't like the NHL. There's no war room in Toronto we can call for a replay."

Shores struck first on an even strength goal in the first period.

The play began with senior Rob Demers throwing the puck on goal, where sophomore teammate Michael DeFranco scooped up the rebound and fired a shot of his own. The puck was turned aside by goalie Tim Rogers. Izaguirre pulled the puck out of the pile and put it home for a 1-0 lead at 7:02.

DiCristofaro wasn't surprised to see the diminutive, but hard-working forward slam one in.

"Nick gives us his heart and soul," DiCristofaro said. "He understands exactly what I want him to do and he'll go out there and do it."

Junior goalie Bobby Fredal finished with 31 saves on the night, including a second period breakaway that he turned aside against the Falcons Kraig Andrews.

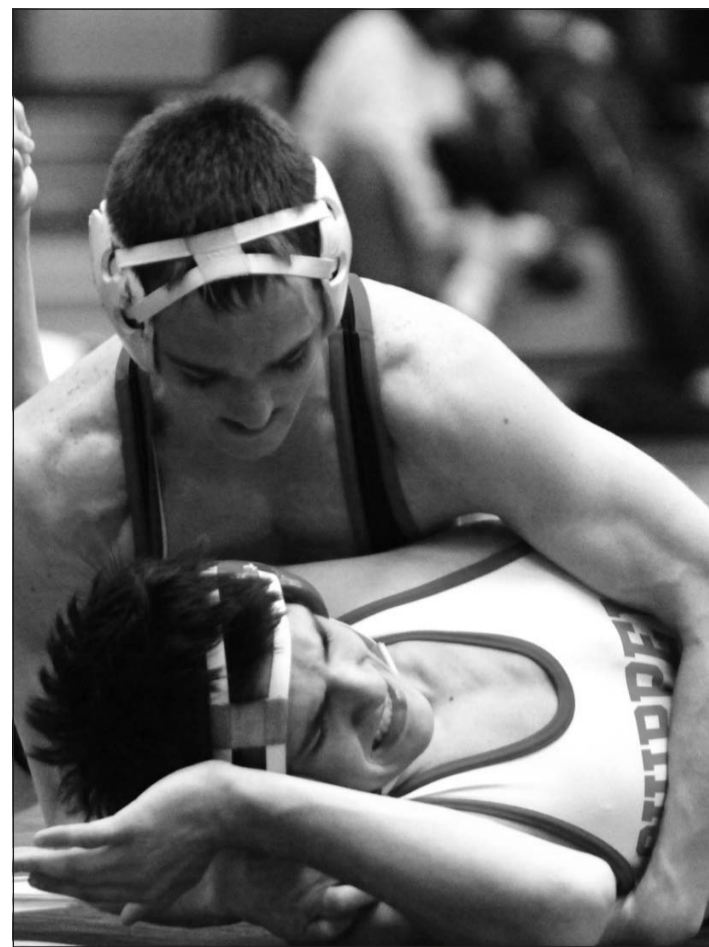
